Policy Language 4.0 Global

Northview Public Schools and its community inspire and develop literate, creative problems solvers, ready for continued learning and career success, while becoming productive, respectful members of society.

Interpretation:

I submit the Board's policy language has been comprehensively interpreted and data submitted to quantify the conclusion statements. Reports have been submitted and accepted by the Board of Education according to the regular schedule of monitoring reports.

Data Reported:

The organization met all expectations except for the following areas of non-compliance:

4.1.1 Literate Students,

Interpretation 1: #1 and #3. Compliance expected by October 2012.

Interpretation 2: #1 and #2. A gain of 2% expected by October 2012.

Interpretation 3: #1, 3, and 4. A gain of 2% expected by October 2012.

4.2.3 Creative Students, #6. Compliance expected by April 2015.

4.3.1 Problem Solver, #3, 5, 6. Compliance expected by October 2012 for #3 and 5. Compliance expected by March 2013 for #6.

4.3.2 Problem Solver, #4. Compliance expected by March 2013.

4.4.4 Continued Learning, #1. Compliance expected by 2013

4.5.1 Career Success, #3. Compliance expected by February 2013.

4.5.3 Career Success, #3 and 4. A gain of 2% expected for 2013.

Conclusion Statement:

There were 151 data measures of the interpretations in the 4.0 Ends policies (4.1 – 4.6). The organization met expectations in 135 and did not meet expectations in 16.

This means that the organization met 89.4% of the expectations and did not meet 10.6% of the expectations.
