1.1.1

1.1.2

These policies include the Board's own governance process, including transition management, board self-assessment and new board member orientation, Board Certification achieved within the first two years of their first term, executive limitations, Board/Superintendent/Staff relations, and desired educational outcomes for the District.

1.1.3

Assurance of financial integrity and stewardship of the District.

1.1.4

Engaging owners and other boards in support of the business of the District.

1.1.5

Advocating for legislative policy development which supports the mission of the District.

1.1.6

Demonstrating leadership on behalf of the District through fund development and on-going communication with the District.
