We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2015-16 educational progress for the Northview Public School District. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. These reports contain the following information:

1. **Accountability Scorecard – Detail Data and Status** - Our district achieved a Yellow Status on the State of Michigan Accounting Scorecard. This indicates that we achieved 60 of the possible 100 points in the accountability rubric. A three color coding scheme is used for proficiency, attendance, and graduation. Green represents meeting a specific target, yellow represents meeting an improvement target, and red represents not meeting the target nor improvement.
2. **Student Assessment Data** – Northview Public School's 2015-16 state assessment results can be found at <https://goo.gl/L8V0nW>. Through careful data analysis the staff has identified key areas for improvement and these will be present in our School Improvement Plan for the 2016-17 school year.

Northview is currently in year two of our School Improvement Plan. As a result of an internal review we will be altering our district School Improvement process to a more inclusive practice. It will be the work of the Northview District School Improvement Team to align all of our schools in a continued effort to improve student achievement across the district.

3. **Teacher Qualification Data** – All teachers in Northview Public Schools are Highly Qualified to teach the content/subjects in which they have been assigned.
