- Student will follow all rules as outlined in the school handbooks. These rules are available for review on the school websites:

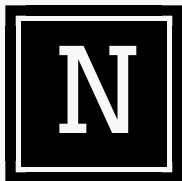

You may want to consider Summer Academy if your student will be in the 7th, 8th, or 9th grade next school year and falls below proficiency levels of standardized tests (such as the MSTEP, Delta, and Fountas and Pinell) or struggled in core academic areas.

What about transportation?

Parents/guardians are responsible for transportation.

What about grades?

This is a supplemental program and therefore will not be part of the grade system or accessible on ParentVue or StudentVue. However, students will get on-going feedback on progress.

What if my student can only attend some of the days?
