May 5 Bond Election

Northview has an important bond that will appear on the May 5 ballot. Despite the ‘Stay Home Stay Safe’ Executive Order, the election will proceed as follows. You may be asking yourself some questions about how that might look. Hopefully we answered them below:

Question: Will there be in-person voting on May 5?

Because of the ‘Stay Home Stay Safe’ Executive Order, Plainfield Township is encouraging absentee voting. However, if you do need to vote in-person on election day, you may do so at the Plainfield Township Hall. No precincts will be open. Please note that strict social distancing perimeters will be in place so wait times may be longer than usual. The address of the Plainfield Township Hall is:

Question: Is it too late to vote by absentee ballot?

No. You still have time to vote by absentee ballot. To request an absentee ballot, please fill out the form linked below. This form must be sent to the Plainfield Township Clerk’s office by hand, via postal mail, fax, or email. This form must be received by the clerk no later than 5:00PM on Friday, May 1.

You may also request an absentee voter ballot in-person at Plainfield Township Hall (address is above). Please call to schedule a time to pick up your absentee voter ballot: 616-364-8466.

All absentee ballots must be received by the Plainfield Township Clerk no later than 8:00PM on Tuesday, May 5. Ballots may be mailed via U.S. Mail or dropped off in person at the Plainfield Township Hall. There is a drop-box in front of the Township Hall that is intended for ballots and is available 24-7.

Question: I’m not even registered to vote yet, can I get registered *and* still vote in the May 5 election?

Yes, you may still register to vote for the May 5 election. Call 616-364-8466 to schedule a time to get registered at Plainfield Township Hall.
