As a reminder, Northview Public Schools works closely with the Kent County Health Department to report, confirm and contact trace positive COVID-19 cases within our school district. In the event that your student is ordered to quarantine due to a 'close contact' with a positive COVID-19 case, you will be notified directly.

Timeline for End of Marking Period Transfers (between in-person and virtual)

All DK-12 families will have the option to transfer between our Northview In-Person program and our Northview Virtual program at the end of the first marking period (October 30, 2020).

Absent a medical reason for a program switch, this will be the last opportunity students have to change programming options for the remainder of the school year. We ask families to carefully consider which learning option best meets the needs of their student and family.
