Timeline for End of Marking Period Transfers (between in-person and virtual)

The enrollment period for families with students in grades **DK-6** to transfer between our Northview In-Person program and our Northview Virtual program is now open. If you would like your student to transfer learning options for the second quarter (beginning November 2, 2020), please complete the form below by *9PM on Monday, October 12*.

Once the form is submitted, a staff member from your child's school office will contact you to confirm the transfer. Please complete the form only once per student.

Due to the complexity of the class schedule at the secondary level, students in grades **7-12** had the opportunity to switch learning programs from September 21 through September 30. At this time, our school counselors are now finalizing second quarter student schedules. Even if you have previously signed up this summer, you will need to complete a new form for each student to be able to ride beginning November 2. This allows our transportation department to plan for route changes, bus capacity and updated drive times.
