As previously mentioned in our September 8 family update, the USDA extended the federal waiver to allow school districts to continue to provide free meals during this school year. We hope that your student has taken advantage of this opportunity to eat *breakfast and lunch at school free of charge!* This means that any student, regardless of family income, is eligible for free school meals. Don't hesitate to take advantage of this opportunity and support our lunch program.

Although all students (ages 18 and under) are eligible to receive free meals, please do complete the free and reduced lunch [application](#) - even if you may not think you qualify. Doing so ensures that we are accurately reporting data to the Center for Education Performance and Information (CEPI). Additionally all data reported is used in the determination of numerous federal and state funding allocations and therefore directly impacts our classroom budgets.
