### **Students in Grades 9-12 Going Virtual from November 18-December 8**

Last night we announced that all Northview students in grades 9-12 would be transitioning to fully remote learning beginning November 18. This is in compliance with the recent MDHHS order. [CLICK HERE](#) to read last night's letter.

Below is some important information to get you started on planning for virtual learning:

- If you are *already* enrolled in Northview Virtual, your daily schedule and course expectations will not be impacted by this transition.
- If you are currently operating in the in-person hybrid model, you will remain in your red/white cohort and adhere to a normal daily schedule. Please click [HERE](#) to view the schedule. All students are expected to participate in live, virtual instruction with their classmates and teacher. Your teacher will share out the specific log in times for each class as well as access links and information prior to your first virtual class using the Canvas LMS. Attendance will be taken.
- **Special Education** and **English Learner** services will be provided virtually unless a specific need arises that requires in-person services. Your teacher will reach out to you with more specific information.
- Our food service department will provide **FREE meals** to any student (regardless of need). To register for a meal, please [CLICK HERE](#). Pick-up is every Wednesday from 11:30AM-12:30PM in front of Northview High School.
