## Wolverine Worldwide Before and After School Care FAQ's

- 1. What are the hours of operation for the YMCA before and after school care programs?**
  - Before School Care (AM) operates from 6:30am-8:00am
  - After School Care (PM) operates from 3:15pm-6:00pm
  
- 2. What are the registration and rate options?**
  - We have a 2 day rate plan and a 5 day rate plan. The rates are as follows:
    - AM and PM Care for 5 Days: \$92
    - PM Care for 5 Days: \$55
    - AM Care for 5 Days: \$55
    - AM and PM Care for 2 Days: \$50
  
- 3. If the school district has a scheduled half day or scheduled breaks, are there YMCA school care options for my child?**
  - Yes! The rates are as follows:
    - Half Day Care: \$0 (included in the cost of child care)
  - On planned school breaks, including winter break, spring break, and summer vacation, families are welcome to register for the Wolverine Worldwide YMCA Day Camps onsite at the facility.
  
- 4. I am enrolling multiple kids in before and after school care. Is there a discount?**
  - Yes! There is a 5% sibling discount that is applied to the registration of the oldest sibling.
  
- 5. Does the YMCA offer care on snow days?**
  - For the safety of the YMCA staff and school care participants, if the school district closes schools due to inclement weather, the YMCA before and after school care programming will not operate.
  
- 6. Will I be charged for a snow day if my child is scheduled to be in before and/or after school care?**
  - Yes, you will be charged. Unfortunately, snow days are an unforeseen closure.
  
- 7. Why can't I access the link to register my child for a site program?**
  - As spaces fill at each school care site, registration will close, which can make the link inaccessible. However, you can be added to a waitlist, which is setup as a first come, first serve system. - 8. What activities will my child participate in during YMCA school care programs?**
  - The YMCA before and after school care staff provide safe and engaging programming focused on leadership development, literacy, STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math) curriculum, CATCH (Health, Wellness, and Fitness) curriculum, 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills, and academic support. Dinner is also provided every day and included in the enrollment cost.
