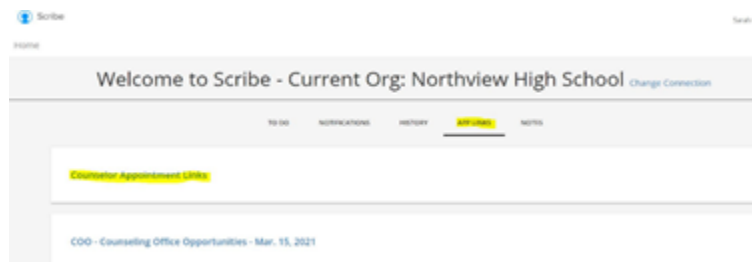

The same confidentiality rules that apply in our offices apply to your results in the wellness checker.

HOW TO SCHEDULE AN IN-PERSON OR VIRTUAL COUNSELOR APPOINTMENTS



- Open up **MAVIN** on phone
- Click on **APP LINKS**
- Click on **COUNSELOR APPOINTMENT LINKS**
- Choose your counselor’s appointment link based on the **1st letter** of your last name

- Schedule **IN-PERSON** or **VIRTUAL** appointment
- Add a description** of the meeting when booking the appointment

-After receiving the email, click **YES** to confirm appointment

*NOTE: Be sure to use your Northview email account when reserving your appointment. To be excused from class, use your confirmation email to show your teacher.

For virtual appointments, the counselors will use *Google Meet*. Click on the blue “Join with Google Meet” button at your appointment time.

To cancel appointment:

-Open original email confirmation

-Click on **OPEN CALENDAR**

-Click on the **3** dots in the top right corner

-Click on **DELETE**
