Parent/Teacher Conferences: Week of October 11

Update to School Visitor Policy

The rules for contact tracing limit visitor opportunities in our school buildings, but not completely. Starting October 1, we welcome visitors in the below circumstances. Please note all school volunteers must have a completed and approved [Volunteer Consent](#) form on file.

- **Northview Mentors** may begin meeting in-person with students on Friday, October 1. Social distancing of at least six feet is required during mentoring sessions. All mentors must follow the masking requirements of the building in which they are mentoring. Masks are highly encouraged, regardless of vaccination status, for Crossroads, Northview High School and NNCC/NNLC. - **Building volunteer opportunities** are limited to activities that do not involve direct contact with students. Assisting with "Friday Folders," bulletin boards, and similar are allowed. Teachers will publish any specific requests for help through their Canvas page. Your school's main office will share specific volunteer opportunities through regular weekly communication. As always, families are welcome to contact the main office for more information on volunteer opportunities.
- Parents/Guardians may **enter the building to pick up their student** in the front office. Unless they have been approved for the above volunteer/mentor opportunities, they may not enter any other part of the building.

COVID-19 Contact Tracing Update

Thank you for your patience as we navigate another year of COVID-19 contact tracing. This year has been particularly challenging as it relates to quarantine requirements *vs* recommendations. In order to streamline and improve the process of notifying families when their student has been identified as a ‘close contact,’ starting *today* our office teams will notify parents/guardians via *email*, not a phone call. If your student is identified as having an exposure at school, you will receive one of two letters:

- “[Recommend to quarantine](#)” (your student was a ‘close contact’ and a quarantine *is* recommended); or
- “[Notice of close contact](#)” (your student was a ‘close contact’ but a quarantine *is not* recommended at this time).

Our staff will continue to make personal phone calls if your student is *required* to quarantine.
