Wolverine Worldwide Before and After School Care FAQ's

1. What are the hours of operation for the YMCA before and after school care programs?

- Before School Care (AM) operates from 6:30am-8:20am
- After School Care (PM) operates from 3:40pm-6:00pm

2. What are the registration and rate options?

- Full Time- AM **and** PM Care for 5 Days: \$120
- AM or PM Care for 5 Days: \$65
- AM or PM Care for 3 Days: \$45
- AM or PM Care for 2 Days: \$30

3. If the school district has a scheduled half day or scheduled breaks, are there YMCA school care options for my child?

- Yes! The rates are as follows:
 - Half Day Care: \$35 (care provided at the school covers from early dismissal time to 6 pm)
 - Full Day Care: \$60 (care provided at the WWW branch from 7 am-6 pm offered on scheduled No School Days and Snow Days)
 - Winter break, Spring break, and Summer vacation, families are welcome to register for the Wolverine Worldwide YMCA Day Camps held at the WWW branch.

4. I am enrolling multiple kids in before and after school care. Is there a discount?

- Yes! There is a 5% sibling discount that is applied to the registration of the oldest sibling.

5. Does the YMCA offer care on snow days?

- For the safety of the YMCA staff and school care participants, if the school district closes schools due to inclement weather, the YMCA before and after school care programming will not operate. Full Day Care may be offered at the WWW branch on closures for inclement weather. Contact Ryan Rose @ rrose@grymca.org the morning of a school cancellation to see if care is offered.

6. Will I be charged for a snow day if my child is scheduled to be in before and/or after school care?

- Yes, you will be charged. Unfortunately, snow days are an unforeseen closure. If you are enrolling in Full Day care because of a closure on a day that you were normally scheduled to attend, your tuition will be pro-rated.

7. Why can't I access the link to register my child for a site program?

- As spaces fill at each school care site, registration will close, which can make the link inaccessible. However, you can be added to a waitlist, which is setup as a first come, first serve system. 8. What activities will my child participate in during YMCA school care programs?

- The YMCA before and after school care staff provide safe and engaging programming focused on leadership development, literacy, STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math) curriculum, CATCH (Health, Wellness, and Fitness) curriculum, 21st Century Skills, and academic support. Dinner is also provided every day and included in the enrollment cost.
