HOW TO SCHEDULE AN IN-PERSON OR VIRTUAL COUNSELOR APPOINTMENTS

Look for the **QR codes** located around the school and on the Counseling office windows to schedule your counseling appointment.

- Schedule **IN-PERSON** or **VIRTUAL** appointment

- After receiving the email, click **YES** to confirm appointment

*NOTE: Be sure to use your Northview email account when reserving your appointment. To be excused from class, use your confirmation email to show your teacher.

For virtual appointments, the counselors will use *Google Meet*. Click on the blue "Join with Google Meet" button at your appointment time.

To cancel appointment:
