

Learning Center Expectations

How it works

- Each student is given 6 classes, making them a full time student. Of those 6, they are registered for 2 to work on at a time. Once those are complete, they then are registered for two more, and so on. Each student is given a total of 6 weeks to complete any given course.

What if I don't complete the class in 6 weeks?

- If the course is not completed in 6 weeks time, it will automatically drop from the system and the student will receive no credit. You will have to restart the course from the beginning!

Attendance at Northview Next Learning Center

- Each student is required to be at the learning center two days a week for a minimum of an hour unless otherwise coordinated with the site director. This gives staff an opportunity to check in with each student, to check class progress, and for students to ask questions or bring up concerns. **Students need to sign-in and sign-out each day they are in attendance.**

Warning and Probationary Periods

- If a student has not finished their assigned courses or been into the center for weekly required minimum hours over the course of two months, they will be placed on warning status. Being placed on warning does not immediately remove you from the program, but acts as a warning period. If course progress is not made during this warning period and you are still not showing up to the learning center for required hours, you will be placed on probation after one month.
- If the problem persists, you will be given a second, and final, probation period to get back on track. If progress is not made or the student falls back off of track after the second probation period, a mandatory placement evaluation meeting will be conducted.
